

SELKIRK DOLPHINS PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Through registering my child with the swim club, I have accepted the terms of this Code of Conduct, and am therefore subject to the Club's rules, and to the rules and regulations of the organizations to which the Club belongs.

- My child swims for their benefit, not mine.
- I will not coach my child – that is the coach's role.
- I will not question official's judgment, integrity or honesty.
- I will support all efforts to discourage verbal and physical abuse
- I will not approach the team Coach during practice or during a meet
- I will show respect for all players, all coaches, all officials and all spectators at all times
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning, so that my child will experience success.
- I will never be present at a practice, meet or team event while under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.
- I will make my child feel like a winner by offering praise for competing fairly and doing their best.
- I will encourage my child to compete according to the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- Children learn by example. I will applaud success for all swimmers
- I will make sure that my child arrives for practices and meets at the time designated by the coach, ready to begin.
- I will not take part in any form of harassment, whether that be to a parent, swimmer, team coach, official or club representative. Bullying in any form, whether in person, electronically (any form of social media) will not be tolerated.
- I realize that failure to abide by the Code of Conduct may result in the removal of myself, and potentially my child, from a practice, event or even the Club.
