High standards of courtesy, fair play and sportsmanship must be featured during all practices and all swim meets.

1. Swimmers will treat fellow athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, event organizers, spectators and others associated with the sport in a courteous and respectful manner.
2. Swimmers will treat everyone respectfully, regardless of gender, place of origin, colour, sexual orientation, religion, or economic status; at all practices, meets, and other team related activities
4. Swimmers will remember that there is no place in sports before, during or after competition for the use of drugs or alcohol of any kind
5. Swimmers will not engage in any behaviour that may be considered harassment /bullying (i.e. physical, verbal, sexual, cyber bullying)
6. Swimmers will respect the honesty and integrity of officials and other swimmers. They will accept the decisions of the officials without question
7. Swimmers will strive to maintain a high degree of physical fitness
8. Swimmers at all times will attempt to do their personal best.
9. Swimmers will follow all team travel policies as described in the Team Handbook.

Swimmers who do not follow this Code of Conduct may be subject to disciplinary action.
